
DION Board Members in Gjøvik



Researcher Spotlight



Davit Gigilashvili

Hi, I'm Davit Gigilashvili, a postdoc at NTNU Colourlab in Gjøvik. As the name suggests, we study color - but that's just the beginning. It's a fascinating field where computer science, physics, graphic design, human vision, and psychology all come together.

My research focuses on two very different topics. The first is about people: how we perceive the visual properties of materials. How do we see colors? How do we recognize transparency or glossiness? Our brains are full of mysteries, and I'm trying to shed some light on them.

The second topic is just as intriguing: reconstructing Viking Age textiles. The Vikings wove stories into their fabrics, but when archaeologists found them, the textiles had crumbled into tiny fragments. Using Al, we're piecing them back together - like a jigsaw puzzle, except we don't know what the final picture is supposed to he

Outside of research, I'm involved with SiN, a national organization representing PhD interests across Norway. If you haven't heard of it, think of it as the "DION of DIONs." I was on the DION board for a while, and as a DION veteran, I'm happy to support PhD interests at the national level.
